

These standard active safety features take collision prevention to the next level by using advanced sensors to monitor your vehicle's surroundings. Intelligent Forward Collision Warning uses these sensors to detect potential oncoming collisions and gives you audible and visual warnings. If you can't react in time, the Automatic Emergency Braking system swoops in and applies the brakes for you.



This isn't the only forward-thinking technology you'll standardly experience in the Altima. You'll also be able to enjoy a standard infotainment system featuring technologies like Bluetooth® hands-free phone system and audio streaming and Siri® Eyes Free.

In between streaming your favorite tunes and making as many phone calls as you want without taking your hands off the wheel, Siri® Eyes Free will give you the capability to use voice commands to control both the infotainment system and your Apple iPhone®.

Your infotainment system is further optimized with the inclusion of a standard RearView Monitor. The infotainment screen switches from play to work when the car is put in reverse and gives you a clear view of what's going on behind you right on your screen. Back up and park with ease knowing exactly what's behind you.

One final highlight you'll enjoy with the Altima is the Nissan Intelligent Key® with Push Button Ignition. This key gives you the ability to lock and unlock the doors and the trunk without having to take your key out of your pocket. Pair this with the Push Button Ignition and you won't need to take your key out at all to get to where you need to go.

As the luxury model, the 2018 Nissan Maxima wastes no time in delivering the best in new technology. Standard in this sedan is a premium 8-inch multi-touch control color monitor, which pairs with a standard Nissan Navigation System, Apple CarPlay™, and Android Auto™.

The Nissan Navigation System is a premium feature that specializes in getting you from Point A to Point B in the most efficient way possible. All you have to do is program in the address or destination you want to get to. Then, this navigation system will give you easy-to-understand, turn-by-turn directions displayed on the monitor the entire way there.



The Maxima also has quite a bit of pep in its step in addition to having quite a few smart features. However, it doesn't stop there. This vehicle goes above and beyond by making convenient features, such as the Remote Engine Start System and Sport Mode Selector, standard.

The Remote Engine Start System is perfect for chilly days. Before you even step out the front door, you can get the car started and warmed up so it's ready to go when you are. The Sport Mode Selector, on the other hand, provides drivers with a bit of extra fun and power customization.

One last highlight of the Maxima comes in the form of safety. Like the Altima, you'll be able to count on standard Intelligent Forward Collision Warning and Automatic Emergency Braking. With so much power under the hood, you'll be thankful to have these features watching over you at all times.

Nissan Sentra Highlights

The 2018 Nissan Sentra, the most compact of the three models, is big in personality with standard features like Bluetooth® audio streaming and Siri® Eyes Free. The latter feature allows you to use voice commands to control elements of your smartphone, such as music and communication.

Also standard in this model is a RearView Monitor that gives a full view of the rear of your vehicle when you put the vehicle in reverse. With this feature, you'll be able to back up and parallel park with confidence.

One additional feature you'll find in the Sentra is NissanConnect® Mobile Apps. This feature gives you the capability to stay connected even when you're the person driving. As a smartphone integration tool, you'll be able to access your apps right from the infotainment screen. Never miss a beat with live updates from your favorite apps, including Facebook and Twitter.



THE MAJOR SIMILARITIES

Let's start with the basics. You'll notice that, as sedans, the 2018 Altima, the 2018 Maxima, and the 2018 Sentra are all equipped with four doors, five seats, and a front-wheel drivetrain. Each of these sedans also offers a smart infotainment system and adjoining features, such as Bluetooth® connectability for audio streaming and safe hands-free phone calling and text messaging.

Speaking of safety, all three Nissan sedans are also equipped with the latest in safety technology while offering even more available safety features, including Blind Spot Warning and Rear Cross Traffic Alert. These features use advanced sensors to keep an eye on every angle of your vehicle, especially the sections you have trouble seeing.

One other similarity you'll see in these three sedans is the optional Midnight Edition trim. This trim in all three models offers exclusive exterior qualities that make for one sleek looking ride. Experience exclusive Midnight Edition black alloy wheels, black exterior accents, and Black Midnight Edition badging.



WHAT SETS THEM APART FROM EACH OTHER

One of the first and most obvious differences you're going to see in these vehicles is the difference in performance. The 2018 Altima and the 2018 Sentra offer powertrains that are built to last for the long-haul while the Maxima focuses more on power. Though you'll still get an EPA-estimated 30 MPG on the highway with the Maxima, this vehicle is best suited for those looking for peppy and sporty.²

Another major difference that you'll see is in terms of interior cargo and passenger volume. The Altima has a bit more wiggle room for passengers with 101.9 cubic feet of interior passenger volume in addition to some extra storage room with 15.4 cubic feet of trunk space.

Additionally, both the Altima and the Maxima offer 45 spacious inches of front legroom, while the Sentra, as the more compact model of the three, gives you 42.5 inches of front legroom. The Sentra, though, redefines "compact" by having the most rear legroom at 37.4 inches.



So, what it boils down to is that each sedan, while capable in their own regard, specializes in one area of expertise or another. The Altima's efficiency makes for happy daily commuters. The Maxima's power output and standard luxury features are good for those looking for a ride that's sporty yet affordable. The Sentra is compact but still manages to give you all the space you need for your passengers and cargo.
